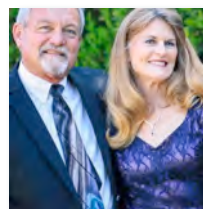

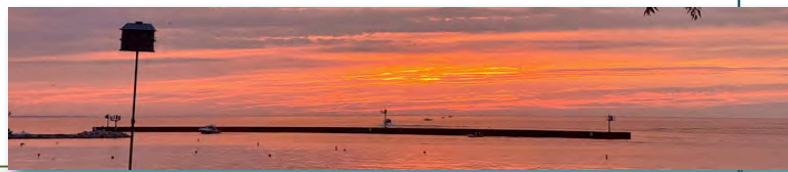

Letter from Pastor Doug Stevens

Dear Linwood Friends,

The Park is a great place to spend the summer, or part of a summer, getting refreshed by the views, the breeze, the celebrations, the people we meet, the sounds of carefree children at play, the leisure and little luxuries we are gifted to enjoy. Can't beat it!

But if God is the Giver of all this, we don't want to take a vacation from Him. He is the Source of our life and all that we have, wherever we are. We remember to be grateful and ask Him what He is refreshing us for. We want to return from weeks away renewed, infused with faith and ready to invest in the real purpose of our lives on this planet.

We are looking at Acts Chapter One on Sunday Mornings this month in the hope of discovering a way forward as followers of Jesus in this uncertain season. Chapter One describes the essential preparation for the journey ahead. Each week we consider the elements of our training that grow our capacity to face the challenges we encounter back home, here in the park, or anywhere in our world. Over six weeks we are reflecting on ...

1) The Reality of the Resurrection and the Priority of the Kingdom of God (last Sunday)

Q: If you are convinced that Jesus is alive and that the call of His Kingdom is to servanthood, are you learning to live fearlessly and lovingly?

2) The Presence and Power of the Spirit (this Sunday)

Q: If the Spirit of God lives in us, are you listening to His voice, energized by His illumination, and moving as He directs you?

3) Waiting on the Lord (July 17)

Q: How do you wait productively --- to absorb the truth, to gain perspective, to build confidence --- without becoming passive or complacent?

4) The Practice of Prayer (July 24)

Q: If prayer is more than an obligation or a ritual, what makes it meaningful and impactful? Does it really make a difference?

5) The Enemy we must Confront (July 31)

Q: How do you subdue the emotions and temptations that threaten to sabotage your best intentions?

6) On Mission (August 7)

Q: Are you willing and able to cross the room, cross the street, cross any and every man-made boundary to embody and express the Gospel?

***Also, join us on Wednesday mornings each week from 10 to 11 am in The Chapel (behind the Tabernacle) for a Bible Study as we transition from the message to the meaning for each of us—from the lecture to the laboratory—to explore and apply what the Word of God is speaking to us and calling us to do from the foundational First Chapter of the Acts of the Apostles.**
