

Linwood Radio A Sound in the Air for a Place in the Heart

When coronavirus hit and the implications began to unfold, a Linwood couple, knowing that things would be different this summer, started brainstorming about creative ways to modify Linwood's typical approach to Christian programming.

They wondered, what if Linwood could broadcast over a radio station, on which we could share information, lift spirits, and encourage Christian community? That conversation has resulted in Linwood Radio, 97.3 FM and linwoodradio.com.

As you can imagine, lots of work has been done since to make this a reality. A transmitter is located in Saffles' cottage on Locust. The station is on 24 hours, and offers inspiring Christian music, from the Jason Lovins Band to True North Chorale and Orchestra. Look for additions to the station offerings as the season progresses.

As *The Breeze* is a fixture at Linwood, we are hoping that the radio station will become a regular feature of life at Linwood.

News From The Stand

The Stand will open on Friday, June 26th and will remain open until August 2.

Daily hours will be from 3:00 - 9:00 p.m. except on July 3rd and 4th, when we will open from 12:00 - 9:00 p.m..

Orders will be take-out only. No inside store purchases.

The menu will consist of: ice cream, milk shakes etc., beverages, popcorn, nachos, candy treats bags, and snacks.

The daily menu will be posted on the outside of The Stand's window and on signage in line.

All sanitary precautions will be taken including: outside hand sanitizers, required social distancing in line. Employee will wear masks and gloves. The Store will be sanitized on a daily basis.

Payments will be taken with credit card or cottage accounts only. Cash will not be accepted.

The surgery is over and Melanie is recovering! Unfortunately, Kathy cannot come back until Melanie is seen by the doctor one more time in about a week. Reminders From the Park Board

PLAYGROUND UPDATE

Governor Dewine has announced that Playgrounds can open on June 10. Matt will disinfect the equipment daily and there will be several hand sanitizer stations in the playground area.

Please encourage your kids to honor social distancing and to use the sanitizers when moving from one piece to the next. If your child is not feeling well or has a temp over 100, please do not let them go to the playground. We want everyone to be safe and stay well

SPEED LIMIT

The speed limit in the park is 10 mph. The kids of Linwood are out in full force on their bikes, roller skates, and just playing. As our most important asset, we want to keep them safe.

GOLF CART RULES

- 1. Operators must have a valid drivers license.
- 2. Operators must obey the same safe driving practices as automobiles in the park.
- 3. Golf cart operation is limited to use on established roads and may not be parked in a manner which interferes with vehicles or pedestrian traffic.
- 4. Golf carts must have fully functioning headlights, brakes and horns, and must not be altered with "high speed kits" or "lift kits" or anything that enhances the performance of the Golf Cart.
- 5. Golf Carts may **NOT** carry more than the number of passengers for which they are designed.

Let's have an enjoyable summer and remember, social distancing is still the new norm at Linwood.

DOG LEASH REGULATIONS

Please remember that dogs are to be on a leash and under the control of the person walking them. Dogs are not allowed on the beach at any time.
