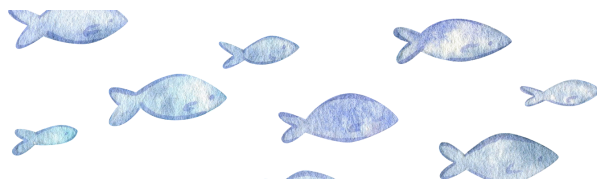

You guys are the best!**

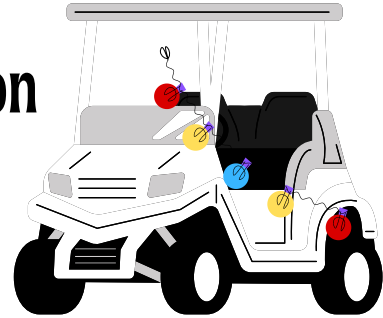

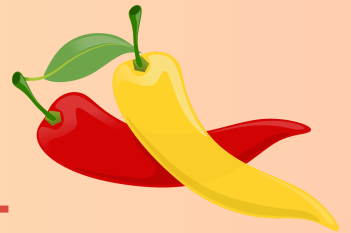

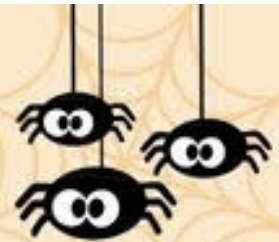
