Hello Linwood friends,

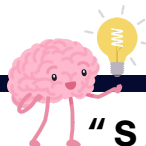

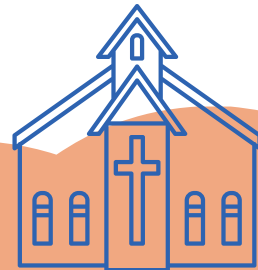
Come out and meet new friends and hang with old ones! After all, part of the joy of being at Linwood is all the amazing friendships that have been made here and the ones that are still yet to come!
