### **News From the Stand**

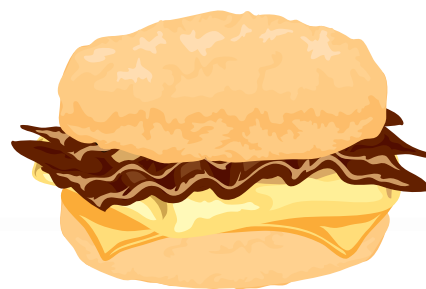
Hours this weekend:
