SUNDAY SCHOOL FOR ADULTS

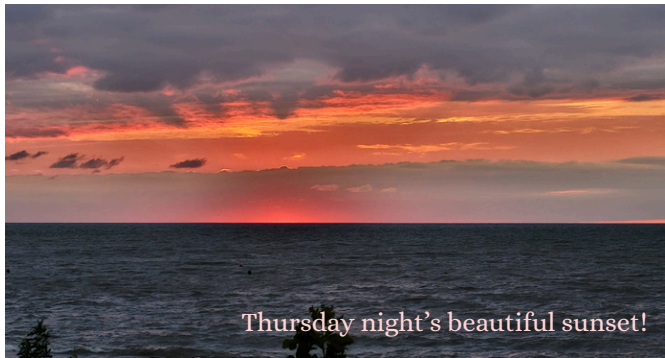
Sunday, 9:45-10:30 a.m. at the Chapel

Sunday, August 10th at 10:45 a.m. on the Bluff (west of the playground)

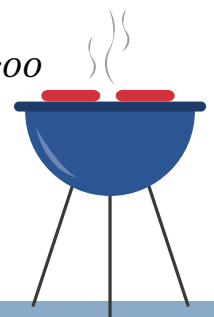

A Message from LCCL Pastor Paul Thwaite

I was blessed to attend Gordon College (not to be confused with Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary) in Massachusetts and earn a degree in History. I began as a Bible major but switched to History when I knew I might be headed to seminary. My years of studying history have led to a lifelong enjoyment of reading history and biography, learning about and appreciating human experience, struggle, and ingenuity.

This means I still enjoy opportunities to hear programs or lectures of a historical nature. This coming Tuesday, the Ritter Public Library here in Vermilion (a wonderful library if you haven't checked it out yet!) is offering a program entitled "**Linwood Park: A Vermilion Treasure**". Based on Karen Boas' book *Through These Gates and Down the Path: Linwood Park*, the program will be a video narrative history of Linwood. The program will take place this **Tuesday, July 22nd at 7 p.m.** in the Library meeting room (5680 Liberty Avenue). It is free and open to the public. I encourage you to attend and celebrate the gift that is Linwood Park!

Sunday morning, our journey down the Pathways of Grace known as the 10 Commandments travels on to the 6th Commandment, You shall not murder. 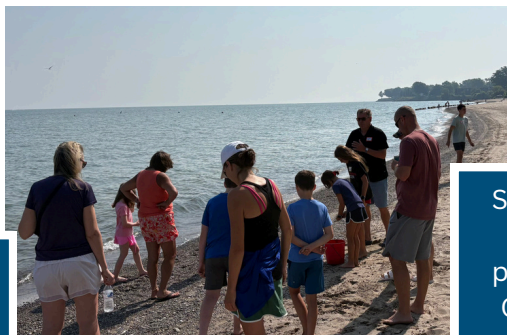

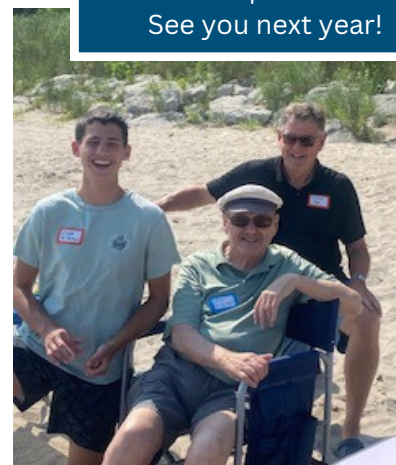
Last Week at the Park...
