

Even into her nineties, no summer was complete without trips to the beach, which became very difficult for her to manage, but we always found a way to get her there safely with family members at her side. She would have loved having this big blue wheelchair to make her daily trek to the beach.

Spending time with family on our beautiful beach is something we want everyone to enjoy, so we would to like to donate this chair in memory of our mom, Jean. As a result, it is available for many years to come for others who may have a need in our Linwood community.
