MINUTE FOR MISSION

Linwood Christian Life provides worship services, faith-based programs, and community activities throughout the season at Linwood Park. All worship services and activities are open to everyone, and visitors are warmly welcomed and encouraged to participate. The Mission Committee of Linwood Christian Life has the task of honoring requests for funds to be used for local, national, and worldwide needs that have a connection to Linwood Park. We will highlight recipients in the next few editions of The Breeze.

Last week, we shared the Almighty Radiant King's (A.R.K.) mission statement. This week we would like to update you on how we serve and how God is working through this endeavor in NE Ohio. Though the A.R.K. was conceived to address the most immediate and critical needs of people, in the last couple years it has aligned with the Cleveland Clinic Department of Pediatric Oncology to address the most dire needs of families who have a child with cancer. For most, the need to be with the child 100% of the time disallows working. Consequently, some families fall behind on mortgage, rent, car payment, insurance, utility bills, medical costs, and much more. Their financial burden is overwhelming and exhausting, particularly in single parent families. All are families who have exhausted every avenue of assistance and have nowhere else to go...thus, the ARK. We are a very last resort. Though we gratefully serve all families regardless of cultural or religious background, this enables us to share the love of Christ at a time when they have nowhere else to turn and no one else to help. It has been amazing to see what the Lord is doing! In 2025, the A.R.K. was able to assist families in excess of \$22,000.00. But, we see a greater need moving forward, as it was shared that more and more children are being diagnosed.

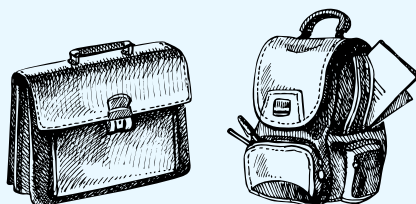

Musings from the Porch: Cottage Owners' Updates

Hi everyone!

Our next cottage owner meeting will be held on Saturday, September 5 at 10:00 AM in the Tabernacle. I hope many of you can attend. We will be raffling off and America 250 flag to someone in attendance. Also, we will be electing officers to serve on the LPCOA Board. The current LPCOA bylaws state that officer terms are one year. However, at the fall cottage owner meeting in 2025, discussion and a vote were taken to amend the LPCOA bylaws to make terms for officers of the LPCOA last 2 years. The majority of people in attendance at that meeting voted in favor of the change. Our bylaws state that in order for a change to be made, the proposed change must be submitted in writing to the cottage owners prior to the meeting and a 2/3 vote is required to amend the bylaws.

So, we are going to reconsider this proposed bylaw change at the meeting on September 5. Here is what is being proposed:

To amend Article IV, Section 3 of the LPCOA bylaws as shown here: "All officers shall be elected for a term of one year two years. The term of office shall begin at the close of the last regular meeting of the year."

Prior to the vote we will allow any discussion and comments you wish to make. Again, a 2/3 vote is required for the change to be made.

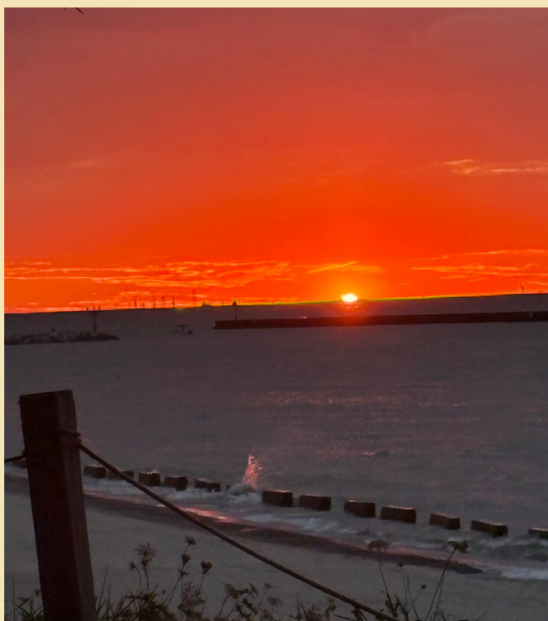
