Hi neighbors. Last week, I spoke with Fred and Marlene Galovich about their past service at the park. Over the past few decades, they, and others, have contributed significantly to Linwood. During our conversation, Fred commented, "there is so much talent among the cottage owners in this park". I wholeheartedly agree with this statement. You – our cottage owners – are a fascinating and talented group. Although we have different backgrounds and interests, we all share one thing in common – our love for Linwood Park.

Based on that love for Linwood Park, I am asking each one of you to consider putting your talent to work for the benefit of all cottage owners. Dick Dreyer, Treasurer, and I have decided to run for the Linwood Park Cottage Owners Association (LPCOA) Board again this fall. Our current Vice President, Judy Crawley, and interim Secretary, Meghan Wolf, have decided to end their tenures with the Board. **So, we are looking for candidates to be Vice President and Secretary for the LPCOA.**

Informally, the LPCOA is a social organization – we sponsor many events throughout the season including the Fourth of July parade. Additionally, we work to ensure the interests of all cottage owners are considered by the Linwood Park Company, regardless of whether the cottage owner is a shareholder in the Linwood Park Company. Formally and according to the LPCOA charter, the LPCOA exists to:

- Preserve Linwood Park as a family summer vacation area complete with religion, sun, shore, and lake;
- Promote, maintain and protect the welfare, rights, privileges, interests, and comforts of cottage owners;
- Encourage communication, fellowship, and the sharing of concerns among cottage owners, and;
- Raise funds for agreed-upon improvements and Park-related projects.

The LPCOA Board meets once per month during the offseason via Zoom. We meet on an as-needed basis during the season.

Please consider using your talents for the benefit of the park by joining Dick and me on the Board for the next two years. Help us continue to maintain and improve the park as a great place to be in a small town on a Great Lake.
