PASTOR PAUL'S MESSAGE



The Summer Olympics have finished in Paris, and it was quite a successful one for athletes from the United States, topping the medal count with 126 medals overall and 40 gold medals, tied with China in that category. There were so many inspiring performances and intriguing human-interest stories shared during the games. But there was one person who was especially inspiring for me – track athlete Sydney McLaughlin-Levrone who set her 6th consecutive world record since 2019 in the 400-meter hurdles! She hasn't lost in that race over the last 5 years of competition! But she is motivated by far greater things than world records and gold medals!

The inspiration for me was in her personal testimony of why she is so successful: "I credit all that I do to God," she said in her press conference. "He's given me a gift, He's given me a drive just to want to continue to improve upon myself, and I have a platform, and I want to use it to glorify Him. So, whenever I step on the track it's always the prayer of, 'God, let me be the vessel in which You're glorified, whatever the result is — how I conduct myself, how I carry myself, not just how I perform.' So, it's just freedom in knowing that regardless of what happens, He's going to get the praise through me. That's why I do what I do."

"God, let me be the vessel in which you're glorified, whatever the result is." That, my friends, is a prayer we can and should all pray as followers of Christ – we are God's vessels through which, in whatever we do, God is to be glorified! "So, whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God." said the Apostle Paul (1 Corinthians 10:31). We may not set world records on the track, but as teachers and doctors and nurses and lawyers and pastors and engineers and business owners and salespeople and retirees and students and husbands and wives and children – we all are called to be vessels in which God is glorified!
