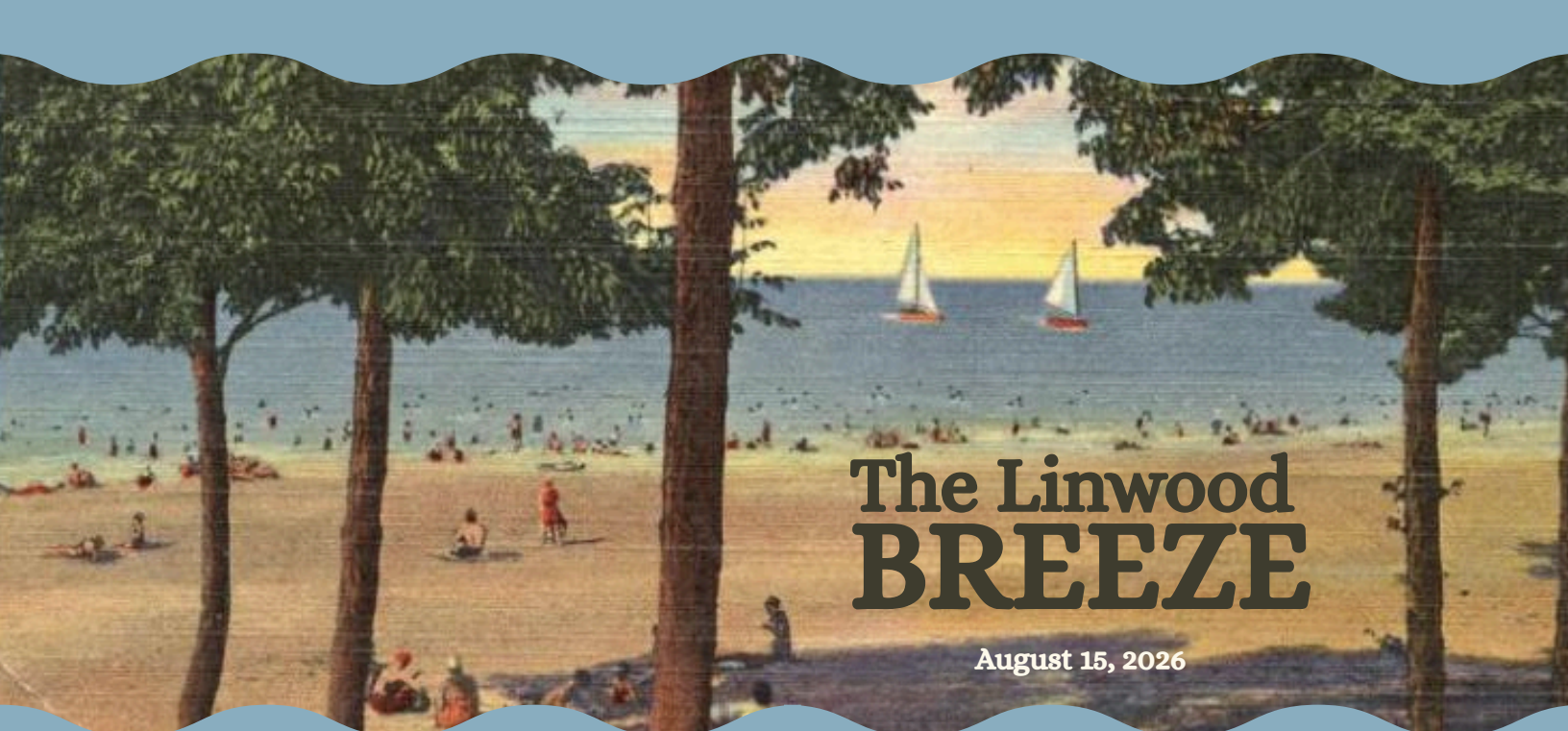

Friends,

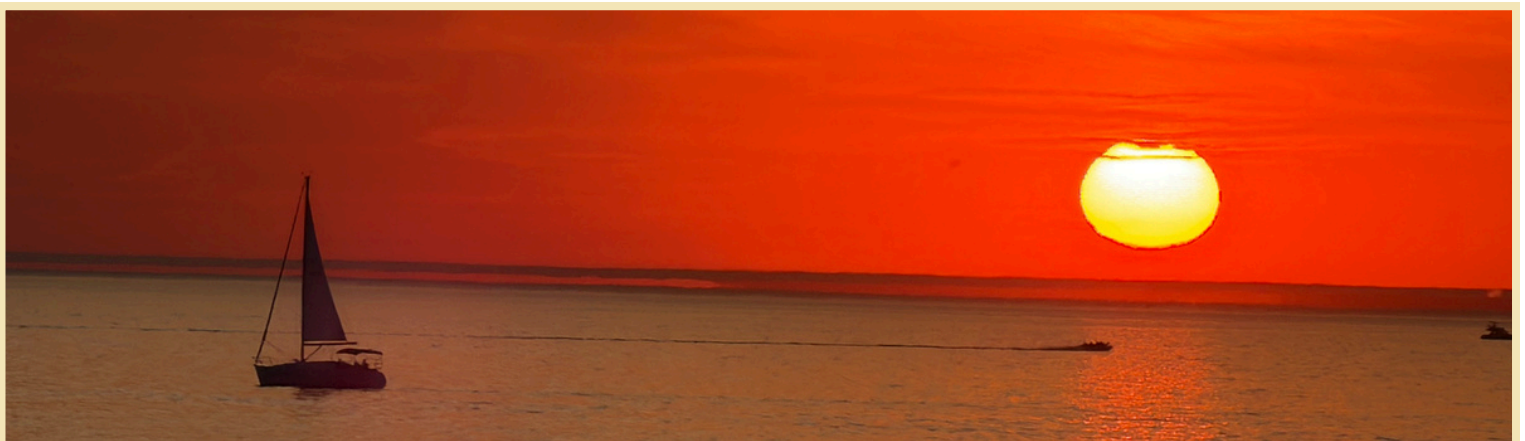

See you soon at Linwood Park.

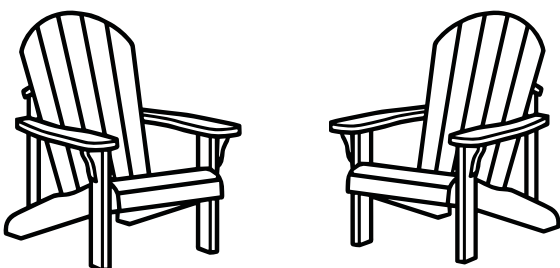

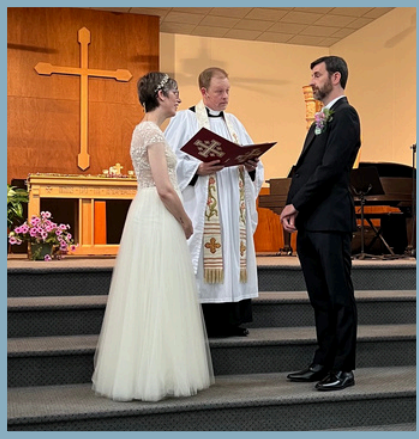
