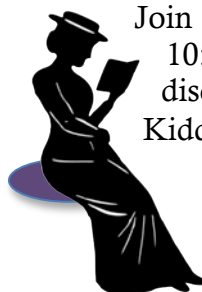
#### ADULT FORUM

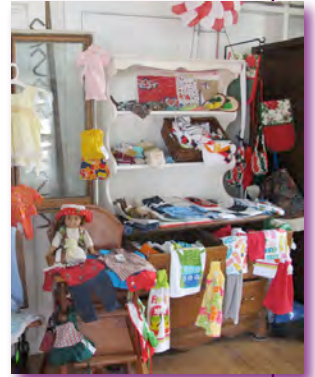
## THE LINWOOD STORE!
