A Message from LCCL Pastor Paul Thwaite

Sunday morning August 3rd we will gather at 10:45 am in the Tabernacle for community worship. As we do each first Sunday of the month, we will celebrate the Lord's Supper together as part of our worship time. Linwood folks may come from different church and denominational traditions, but we all share the common foundation of our faith in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of our sin and empowering us for life as followers of Jesus Christ. I hope you will consider this a personal invitation from your Park Pastor to be with us in worship this Sunday morning!

All summer long we have been looking together at the 10 Commandments as Pathways of Grace, ways in which God calls us to live so we might experience his grace and blessing in our lives. "Oh, that their hearts would be inclined to fear me and keep all my commandments always, so that it might go well with them and their children forever." (Deuteronomy 5:29) is God's heartfelt plea to his children! We begin by honoring God and his name and majesty, and we continue by honoring our fellow human beings in actions of love and faithfulness. This week, we will look at the Eighth Commandment - You shall not steal - as we consider God's call to a faithful understanding of how we use material possessions.

A book entitled The Evangelical Church in Ohio written by Roy Leedy had this to say about Linwood: "Linwood is destined to become a rallying point for our Church. ...Let us not cease to labor and pray that Linwood may become more and more a place for the promotion of that true spiritual life which will constitute the church a living power unto the salvation of the world." While Linwood is no longer connected with a specific church or denomination, it is still very much "a place for the promotion of that true spiritual life." In our worship, our bible study and prayer meetings, our times enjoying God's creation on the beach or during a sunset, our interactions with family and friends, all these things are tools God uses to shape and mold our true spiritual life, regardless of what particular church we may be part of outside of Linwood. I encourage you to be aware of and seeking God's presence in your life ("Seek the Lord and his strength; seek his presence continually", Psalm 105:4) during your stay here with family and friends in this special place known as Linwood Park!
